
### THE NAVY CHAPLAIN IN PEACE AND WAR

(AN INSPIRATIONAL STORY OF THE EUCHARIST)

There is not a Holy Mass that I have celebrated since my ordination on May 26 1973, in which the reality of the real presence of Christ has not profoundly moved me.



### To make Christ present to others: This is my call—my life

As a Navy Chaplain since June 1984, I have celebrated Holy Mass in the field: my altar has been a rock, a stretcher, piled ammunition boxes and even food boxes with a simple linen and corporal. The real presence of Christ was felt there, for those soldiers, whether in training or real war environment. *Christ was there!* 

I have celebrated Holy Mass aboard ships: in the chapel, a classroom in the foç's'le, on deck, on the ledge of a missile launcher( this last one raised some eyebrows until II told the sailors: "You may have to fire

these, **So let's pray for peace**". They did fire them, two days after I left the ship. The real presence of Christ was important to them in a time of War.

I have celebrated Holy Mass under the sea: aboard a submarine, and in the confines of the deep, the real presence of Christ was brought to His people.

I have celebrated Holy Mass in the field: during Operation Desert Storm and during war as the chaplain for Fleet Hospital Eight in Rota, Spain, where we cared for hundreds of wounded Marines, soldiers, sailors, air men and women and civilians from the battlefields of Iraq and Afghanistan. *The real presence of Christ was there for His Children*.

In all these places, God's Son, Our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ, was made present, to bring

renewed faith, hope, love and healing, to the trusting and faithful men and women, in peace time and in war.

The real presence of Christ, what an awesome gift, a daily blessing!

And I have the honour to make present at the altar, this wonderful gift of His body and blood, soul and divinity. As I bring this gift into the world. I think of one thing... Every time you or I receive this real presence in the Eucharist, we hear Christ say: "Behold, I make all things new."

No matter what is going on in our lives, one thing is for sure:

"Behold I am with you always even to the end of time" ...
Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world. Happy are they called to His supper."
... I am not worthy... I shall be healed"



#### AN EXTRACT FROM THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH God did not make death

God did not make death, and he does not delight in the death of the living...It was through the devil's envy that death entered the world.

Satan or the devil and the other demons are fallen angels who have freely refused to serve God and his plan. Their choice against God was definitive. They try to associate man in their revolt against God... "Although set by God in a state of rectitude, man, enticed by the evil one, abused his freedom at the very start of history. He lifted himself up against God and sought to attain his goal apart from him" (GS13.1) By his sin Adam, as first man, lost the original holiness and justice he had received from God, not only for himself but for all human beings.

Adam and Eve transmitted to their descendants human nature wounded by their own first sin and hence deprived of original holiness and justice; this deprivation is called "original sin".

As a result of original sin, human nature is weekend in its powers; subject to ignorance, suffering, and the domination of death; and inclined to sin (concupiscence).

"We therefore hold, with the Council of Trent, that original sin is transmitted with human nature, 'by propagation, not by imitation' and that it is ... 'proper to each'" (Paul VI,CPG.16).

The victory the Christ won over sin has given us greater blessings than those which sin has taken from us: "where sin increased, grace abounded all the more"(Rom.5:20)

Christians believe that "the world has been established and kept in being by the Creator's love; has fallen into slavery to sin but has been set free by Christ, crucified and risen to break the power of the evil one..."

### **Hypocrisy:** Hypocrisy will certainly be exposed some day, Beware of it!!!!.

#### THE GOSPEL REFLECTION OF THE MONTH:

"The Counsellor, the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send you in my name, he will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you". (John 14:26)

During the last supper, while Jesus was preparing his disciples for his passion, knowing that they will be frustrated by his sufferings and crucifixion, he promised them that when he goes he will send them, the Advocate, the Counsellor, the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit is the third Person of The Most Holy Trinity. To confirm the necessity of the presence of the Holy Spirit in the Church, the first time Jesus appeared to his disciples after his resurrection, said to the Apostles, "As the Father sent me, so I am sending you"...."Receive the Holy Spirit. For those whose sins you forgive they are forgiven; for those whose sins you retain, they are retained". And as St Paul says in his 1st Letter to the Corinthians, "One cannot believe in Jesus Christ without sharing in his Spirit. It is the Holy Spirit who reveals to men who Jesus is." All this shows us how important is the presence of the Holy Spirit in Church and us.

Because as St Paul continues to teach us, the particular way in which the Spirit is given to each person is for a good purpose and he compares Christ's body, the Church, with the human body that is made up of many parts but form one body; so also we who are baptised form one body, each one to serve in his particular place and mission.

Jesus compares the Holy Spirit with water. Talking to the Samaritan woman said, "The water that I shall give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life". Jesus was talking of the Holy Spirit, the Spirit of God; because as all living things depend on water so our soul needs the Holy Spirit. Water comes down from heaven as rain and is always the same yet its effects are various, are according to the subject. It adopts itself to the nature of the things which receive it and it becomes what is appropriate to each. (St Cyril).

The problem is that when water dries up every living creature meets the same fate, it dies and disappears. So also happens with us human beings. If the Grace of the Holy Spirit in our souls dries up or becomes short it weakens and dries up. However what must we do not to experience such a disastrous end? In this month we have another big feast, The Corpus Christi Day, the feast of the Sacred Body and Blood of Jesus. Jesus warned us, "Truly, truly, I say you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of man and drink his blood you have no life in you; he who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life" (John 6-53-55). The Holy Spirit and the Body and Blood of Christ go hand in hand, the Holy Spirit bring us close and increase our love towards the Holy Eucharist and the Holy Eucharist increase our faith and trust in the Holy Spirit.

However this happens under one condition, that we receive the Holy Eucharist with clean heart, with no stain of mortal sin and given due respect.
